Fill The Bus

Once again The Bismarck Jaycees are helping Bismarck Public Schools and Y-93 with Fill the Bus. For those of you who don't know about this, it is a one day event where one bus is parked at each Red Carpet Car Wash location in Bismarck and their goal is to fill the buses full of school supplies for needy children in the area. I helped with this project last year and found it to be very fulfilling. It gave me a profound sense of helping others in the community and I was in awe of all the generous donations from others. It truly was a rewarding experience!

This year the Jaycees have pledged to help even more. We have offered to help on the day of the event collecting the supplies and also the day after with sorting and extra help as needed. So, I am asking you to start thinking of how you can help. This is the information that I received from Bismarck Public Schools:

Fill The Bus is on Monday, August 18. I am not sure of the exact times, but think last year, it went from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. The buses will be at Red Carpet Car Wash north and south locations. One person is needed to help at each location throughout the day. I will set up a schedule to for people to work in 1 hour shifts. This is very easy work; you just have to help Y-93 load school supplies into the buses as people drop them off. Sorting will take place the next day on Tuesday August 19. They are requesting help from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will need 4-5 people until 1 pm. and two people until 4 p.m. The BHS football players and Demonettes will do the unloading and preliminary sorting. They need the Jaycees help in sorting and possibly doing runs for exchanges and buying missing items.

I am asking you to start thinking about the times you are able to help on this worthwhile project. I know it is during the week when most everyone is working, but please consider working it around your lunch hour or take an hour or two of vacation to help out. This is great advertisement for the Bismarck Jaycees as it gets our name out in the community and last year, they continuously said our name on the air. We need your help to make this a success! I will start a signup sheet at the July meeting for working shifts. Also, we would like to donate as well, so if anyone has any ideas for a fundraiser, please contact me.
