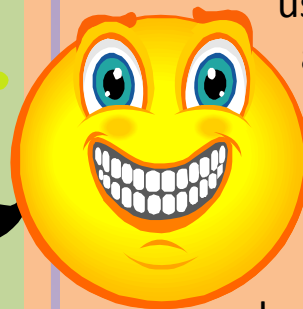
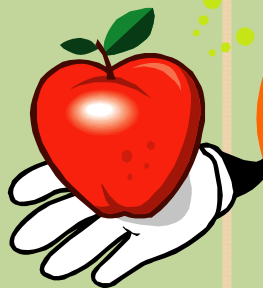

Once again The Bismarck Jaycees are helping Bismarck Public Schools and Y-93 with Fill the Bus. For those of you who don't know about this, it is a one day event where one bus is parked at each Red Carpet Car Wash location in Bismarck and their goal is to fill the buses full of school supplies for needy children in the area. Fill the Bus is on Wednesday, August 18 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. The buses will be at Red Carpet Car Wash north and south locations. One person is needed to help at each location throughout the day. I will set up a schedule to for people to work in 1 hour shifts. This is very easy work as you just have to help Y-93 load school supplies into the buses as people drop them off. Sorting takes place the next day on Thursday August 19. At this time, I do not have any information from



Bismarck Public Schools. I hope to have some more information at the July meeting. In the past, they usually start around 8 a.m. with sorting the supplies. The schools then come in the afternoon to pick up the supplies. Usually more help is needed in the morning and less in the afternoon. If you cannot help on Wednesday, consider helping on this day.
